DECLARATION OF PESTALCTIONS

THIS DECLARATION made and dated the <u>lith</u> law of October. . 1974 . Cy MINNESOTA TITLE COMPANY of PRIZONA, an Arizona comporation, as Trustee, being owner of all of the following described oremises, situated in the County of Maritopa, State of Arizona, to-mit

Restrictions herein, if any, based on race 1 to fifteer 15 fc. size. APPLIO ESTATES of Restrictions herein, if any, based on race 2 to ffee plat of record in the office color, religion, sex, handicap, of the County Recorder of Marticopa County, Arrizona in glatus or national origin are delegated 174 of Maps, page 45 increof.

Whereas, seld declarant is about to convey partels of said real trongerty around on said Map and desires to subject the same to centain restrictions, conditions, coverants and agreements at herinafter set forth in furtherance of a jeremain plan for the improvement of said tract:

hOW. THEREFORE, the undersigned owner of the hardinate a described property bereby declares that said property is held and shall be conveyed subject to restrictions, conditions, covenants, charges and agreements set forth in this lectarist or to-wit:

- 1. LAND USE AND BUILDING TYPE: No iot shall be used except for residential purposes. No building shall be erected, altered, placed or permitted to recain on any lot other than one detached single-family dwelling not to exceed one story in height and a private garage. One and one-half (1), and two (2) story single-family dwellings may be constructed only with the approval of the Architectural Committee; no business, trade or manufacturing of any nature or description shall be carried on or transacted on any portion of said property nor shall any part of said premises be used as a hospital or sanitarium or other place for hire for the care or entertainment of persons suffering from any disease or disability whatsoever.
- 2. ARCHITECTURAL CONTROL: No building shall be erected, placed or altered on addition that the construction plans and specifications and a plan showing the location of the structure have been approved by the Architectural Control Crazittee as to quality of workmanship and materials, harmony of external design with existing structures, and as to location with respect to topography and finish grade elevation.
- 3. SIZE: The floor area of the owelling, exclusive of borches, garages, carport, and patios, shall be not less than 1500 square feet unless otherwise approved by the Committee. No prefabricated building or other structure of any nature whatsoever, permanent or temporary, shall be moved or placed upon, or assembled or otherwise maintained on any lot, provided, nowever, that a temporary office, trailer office, tool shed, lumber shed and/or sales office may be maintained upon any lot or loss by any building contractor for the purpose of erecting and selling dwellings on a lots, but such temporary structures shall be removed at complettor of construct or sciling of dwelling, whichever is later.
- 4. BUILDING LOCATION: We building small be located on any lot nearer to the front line than thirty (30) feet, no buildings shall be located nearer than seven (7) feet to any interior lot line, nor closer than ten (10) feet to a side lot line adjacent to ϵ street, except that side yards for detained garages and other permitted acessor, buildings located in the rear one-half of the lot need only conform to the require est of the County of Maricopa. A corport and storage room attached to the walls of the chelling may be placed not closer than three (3) feet to an interior lot line and att closer than ten (10) feet to a side lot line adjacent to a street. For the purpose of this covenant, however, that this shall not be construed to permit any portion of a building on a lot to encroach abon another lot. In the event an owner acquires a port of of any adjoining lot or lots, the foregoing measurements small be made from such darside property lines rather than From the side lot lines indicated on said recorded on. or plat. None of said lots shall be resubdivided into smaller lots non conveyed or encurtared in less than the full original dimension of such lots as shown by the than of APOLLO ESTATES UNIT FIVE, except for public utilities, provided that this restriction shall not prevent the conveyance or encurprance of adjoining or contiguous lots or carts of lots in such a manner as to create parcels offand in a common ownership having the same or a greater street frontage than shown on the plat of APOLLO ESTATES LITT FIVE for any one of the lots, portions of which are so conveyed or encumbered. Thereafter, parts of adjoining or contiguous lots in such common ownership, shall, for the purchase of these restrictions, be considered as one lot. Nothing herein contained shall in en-

the dedication or converance or portions of luts for quotic stillings, in which event the remaining portion of any lat shall, for the purpose of this provision. be treated as a whole lot

- 5. Fences: 'No fence or wall higher than six (b) feet shall be constructed across the rear property line of any lot: for shall any fence or wall be constructed both any lot unless its design and style are first approved by said Committee. Fences or walls constructed within the area of the minimum front or side street setback fines (as defined in Paragraph No. 4 herein) shall not exceed two (2) feet six (b) inches in height; fences or walls constructed on any side lot line shall not exceed six (6) feet in height.
- 6: Easements: Easements, as indicated upon the recorded Map of this subdivision, are reserved for the installation and maintenance of public service utalities and other uses for public or quasi-public good. No building shall be placed upon such easements or interference be made with the free use of the same for the purposes intended.
- 7. NUISANCES: No norious or offensive activity shall be carried on upon any lot, nor shall anything be done thereon which may be or may become an annoyance or nuisance to the meighborhood.
- 6. TEMPORARY STRUCTURES: No structure of a temporary character, trailer, basement, tent, shack, bar, garage, or other outbuilding shall be used on any lot at any time as a residence either temporary or permanently.
- 9. SIGHS: No sign of any kind shall be displayed to the public view on any lot except one righ of not more than five (5) square feet, advertising the property for sale or rent, or as approved by the Architectural Committee, or as placed by the developer during the period of development of this subdivision.
- 10. Livestock AND PORETRY: he animals, livestock or poultry of any kind shall be raised, bred or kept on any lot, except that dogs, cats or other household pets may be kept provided that they are not kept, bred or maintained for any commercial purpose. Horses may be kept for single-family use subject to rules and regulations of the County of Maricopa, and approval of the Architectural Countities.
- 11. Serbage and Refuse Disposal: two lot shall be used or maintained as a dumping ground for rubbish. Trash, garbage or other waste shall not be kept except in sanitary containers. All incinerators or other equipment for the storage or disposal of such material shall be kept in a cleak and sanitary condition.
- 12. O.L AND MINING OPERATIONS: No cit orilling, oil development operations, oil refining, quarrying or mining operations of any kind thell to permitted upon or in any lot, nor shall oil wells, tanks, tunnels, numeral incavations or shafts as left mitted upon or in any lot. No decreick or other structure designed for use in bortom for oil or natural gas shall be erected, maintained or permitted upon any lot.
- 13. SIGHT DISTANCE AT INTERSECTIONS: No fence, wall, hedge, or shrub planting which obstructs sight lines at elevations between two (2) and six (4) feet above the roadways, shall be permitted to remain on any corner lot within the triangular area formed by the street property lines and a line connecting them at points twenty-five (25) feet from the intersection of the street lines, or in the case of a rounded property corner from the intersection of the street property lines extended. No treashall be permitted to remain within such distances of such intersections unless the fullage line is maintained at sufficient neight to prevent obstruction or such sight lines.
- 14. COMPLETION OF CONSTRUCTION: Any building in this subdivision the construction of which has been started, shall be completed without delay, except when such delay in caused by acts of God, strikes, actual inability of the owner to procure deliver of werestary material, or by interference by other persons or forces beyond the control of the number to prevent. Financial inability of the owner or his contractor to secure labor or materials or discharge liens or attachments shall not be deemed a cause beyond his control.
- 15. CARE OF PROPERTIES: All vacant nots in this subdivision shall be at all times kept free of rubbish and litter, weeds and gress shall be diseed out or kept well mown so as to present a tidy appearance. The yards and grounds in connection with all improved properties shall be at all times kept in a neat and signtly condition and shall be

cultivated and planted to any extent sufficient to maintain an appendicular allocal temping with that of typical improved properties in this subdivision. During prolonger absence, pumer of said lot agrees he will arrange for the care of the property, during such absence. In the event a lot owner does not maintain his lot in a neat, proper manner, any sic reighbors, acting in concert, may have said lot cleaned up and upon refusal to pay within thirty (30) days from cate upon filing an affidavit that said owner refuses to maintain said lot in a neat and proper manner, may file said affidavit in the Office of the County Recorder of Maricopa County, State of Arizona stating the amount therein and to whom it was paid as it the date and such amo it shall constitute a lien against said lot. No over-night parking for any trucks, pickup trucks, ortrailers will be permitted in the street, and further no vehicles other than passenger cars and pick-up trucks will be parked to oper carports.

- 16. DRAINAGE EASEMENT: Purchaser shall not at any time hereafter fill, block or obstruct any drainage casements and drainage structures on the demised premises, nor shall purchaser cause or suffer to be eracted on the demised premises any building or obstruction for the purpose, directly or indirectly, or obstructing, blocking or filling any such drainage easement or drainage structure, and purchaser agrees to make and forever to repair and maintain all such drainage easements and drainage structures on the demised premises, making good nevertheless, at not mun expense, alldamage which may be casued to the said drainage easements and structures on the demised land, and purchaser agrees to repair at his own expense, all damage to any structure on any lot which may be caused directly or indirectly, by this obstruction blocking or filling any such drainage easements.
- 17. ARCHITECTURAL CONTALL COMMITTEE: The Architectural Control Committee shall be composed of L. J. MOODAN, VERNON PINKERTON AND STANLEY O. MOODAN. A majority of the Committee may designate a representative to act for it. In the event ofdeath or resignation of any member of the committee, the remaining members shall have full authority to designate a successor. Neither the members of the committee, nor its designated representative, shall be entitled to any compensation for services performed pursuant to this coverant. At any time, the then record owners of a majority of the 15 lots shall have the power through a duly recorded written instrument to change the membership of the Committee or to withdraw from the Committee or restore to it any of its powers and duties.
- 18. APPROVAL PROCEGURE: The Committee's approval and or disapproval as required in these covenants, shall be in writing. In the enthe Committee, or its designated representative, fails to approve or disapprove within thirty (30) days after plans and specificiations have been submitted to it, or in any event, if no suit to enjoin the construction has been commenced prior to the committee have been fully compiled with.
- 19. **DOMINANT TENEMENT:** Each of the lots in said tract shall constitute the dominant tenement and be entitled to the benefit of the covenants herein contained as against all of the other lots in said tract which shall constitute the servicest tenements.
- 20. IERS: These covenants are to run with the land and shall be binding on the undersigned and all of its successors in title, interest or possession in all and every part of said premises until July 1, 2005, and thereafter said covenants shall be autoratically extended for successive periods of ten (10) years, unless and until the owners of a majority of the lots affected hereby amend or revoke the same by written instrument, duly acknowledged, and recorded.
- 21. <u>DEEDS:</u> Deeds of conveyance of all or any of said lots shall incorporate by reference all of the provisions contained in this document. "However, whether or not racited in the deeds of conveyance, these restrictions shall be binding on every runce of every lot in this subdivision."
- 22. ENFORCEMENT: If the owner or possessor of any lot subject to these restrictions shall violate, or attempt to violate, any of the covenants herein, it shall be lawful for any other person or persons owning any real property situated in said tract to prosecute any proceeding at law or in equity against the person or persons violating or attempting to violate any such covenants and either to prevent him or them from so deingor to recover damages for such at lation, or both.
- 23. SUBDROIMATION: Nothing contains in this Declaration shall be held to invalidate the lien of any mortgage or deed of trust prior to foreclosure, provided, however, that any purchaser at any mortgage foreclosure sale or sale under deed of trust shall hold title subject to all the previsions hereof.

24. SEVERABILITY: Invalidation of any one of these covenants by judgment or court order shall in no wise affect any of the other provisions, which shall remain in full force and effect.
